- 4. The applicant must provide a current copy of their transcript. Unofficial transcripts are acceptable.
- 5. The applicant must complete the attached application form.
- The application must be postmarked or emailed by MAY 3 to be considered.
 Applications dated after May 3rd or incomplete applications will not be considered.
